MANTI CITY PUBLIC HEARING
MAY 19, 2010
6:00 P.M.

Mayor Natasha R. Madsen welcomed those present at the hearing and requested they sign the attendance roll being circulated.

Mayor Madsen stated the purpose of this hearing is to accept comment regarding the proposed application to the Community Impact Board for the upgrade of the sewer lagoons.

She requested that those wishing to make comment regarding the application or the project wait to be recognized and then state their name for the record and requested that comments be to the point and as brief as possible.

1. Councilmember Christiansen said his feelings on the sewer project are known and have been stated previously and for that reason he will not comment.
2. The City Recorder stated that the project estimates of approximately \$700,000 may need to be revised depending on review by the appropriate state agencies and cost for the project could go as high as \$800,000. He felt loan application should be made to accommodate an increase in costs should it occur.
3. Mayor Madsen noted that this is an important project to the infrastructure of Manti City and felt it should go forward.

As there were no other comments Mayor Madsen closed the hearing with the provision that if additional individuals appeared and wished to make comment prior to 6:30 p.m., the hearing would be reopened to accept their comments.
